This invitation for Tenders follows the General procurement notice (GPN) 5933-GPN-38382 for this project which was published in 'Procurement Opportunities' on the EBRD website: 28 April 2009 and recently updated on 6 July 2011.

State Unitary Enterprise "Vodokanal of St. Petersburg", hereinafter referred to as the Employer intends to use funds of the loans and technical assistance from international banks and donors towards the costs of the "Neva Direct Discharges Closure Programme".

The Employer now invites sealed tenders from the contractors for the following contract to be financed from part of the proceeds of the loans from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD), Nordic Investment Bank (NIB) and European Investment Bank (EIB): Installation of equipment and construction of the service building associated with the technological equipment of the shaft for wastewater distribution facility (URS-422) in accordance with the Employer's Design.

The scope of works under this contract shall include:

- Civil works associated with the service building
- Mechanical and piping works in the underground part and the service building of URS-422
- Automation and Electrical works,
- HVAC

The project site is located in the city of St. Petersburg.

The estimated completion time under the contract is 12 months.

Tendering for contracts to be financed with the proceeds of the loans from the Banks is open to firms from any country.

To be qualified for the award of a contract, tenderers must satisfy the following requirements:

- (a) The Tenderer shall have an average annual turnover as prime contractor (defined as billing for works in progress and completed) over the last 3 (three) years not less than EUR 20 mln. (twenty million Euros) equivalent.
- (b) The Tenderer shall demonstrate that it has successful experience in the execution of at least 1 (one) project of a nature and complexity comparable to the proposed contract, with a value of at least 10 mln. (ten million) Euros equivalent, within the last 5 (five) years.
- (c) The Tenderer and its subcontractor(s) shall have or obtain prior to commencement of works all certificates and permits required by the legislation of the Russian Federation for design and construction contracts (such as certificates for design, construction and capital repairs issued by respective Russian self-regulating organizations). The Tenderer should demonstrate that such licenses, certificates and permits will be obtained prior to commencement of works.
- (d) The Tenderer shall demonstrate that it has access to, or has available, liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means sufficient to meet the construction cash flow for the contract for a period of 3 (three) months, estimated as not less than EUR 3.5 mln. (three million five hundred thousand Euros) equivalent.
- (e) The Tenderer shall submit balance sheets audited or supported by the documents issued by tax authorities of the tenderer's country of origin for the last three (3) years demonstrating the soundness of the Tenderer's financial position and showing long-term profitability.
