This Invitation for Tenders follows the General Procurement Notice for this project which was published on the EBRD website, Procurement Notices (www.ebrd.com) on 28 February 2011, updated on 16 April 2012.

The Municipality of Bodrum, hereinafter referred to as "the Employer", intends using part of the proceeds of a loan from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (the Bank) towards the cost of Rehabilitation of Existing Water Reservoirs.

The Employer now invites sealed tenders from contractors for the following contract to be funded from part of the proceeds of the loan:-

- Rehabilitation of the concrete structure of the 6 existing water reservoirs with an area of 8,630 m²
- Application of special waterproof mortar lining of all walls, columns, floor and ceiling of all 6 existing reservoirs
- Replacement of all existing butterfly valves
- Installation of electromagnetic flow meter and data logger, ready for SCADA
- Rehabilitation of the control rooms for safety and appearance

Tendering for contracts to be financed with the proceeds of a loan from the Bank is open to firms from any country.

To be qualified for the award of a contract, tenderers must satisfy the following minimum criteria:

- The Tenderer (single tenderer, one JV partner or sub-contractor) shall demonstrate that it has successful experience as a prime contractor in the execution of at least two projects of a nature and

complexity comparable to the proposed contract within the last 5 years;

- Specific experience in reservoir and concrete structure rehabilitation (by a single contractor, one JV partner or sub-contractor).
- The Tenderer shall have an average annual turnover as prime contractor (defined as billing for works in progress and completed) over the last 3 years of not less than EURO 2,000,000 equivalent

Tender documents may be obtained from the office at the address below upon payment of a non-refundable fee of EURO 200 or the equivalent in a convertible currency. Tender documents in hardcopy will be available by 19. April 2012.
