Georgia has received a loan from the European Investment Bank (hereinafter referred to as "the Bank") toward the cost of Water Infrastructure Modernization Project, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to payments under the Contract for Rehabilitation of Lentekhi (Stage II) and Martvili Water Supply Systems and Tsageri Water Supply Headwork "Tsivtskaro" for The United Water Supply Company of Georgia (Contract # EIB/WIMP/W/ICB/13).
- The Municipal Development Fund of Georgia now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for works: Rehabilitation of Lentekhi (Stage II) and Martvili Water Supply Systems and Tsageri Water Supply Headwork "Tsivtskaro".
 - Lot 1 Rehabilitation of Lentekhi Water Supply System (Stage II). The design stipulates that the water from Skiamuri headworks should be supplied to the pressure reservoir and water from Tavadi Spring should be supplied to Karishi reservoir where from it will be supplied to Daba Lentekhi network.
 - Lot 2 Rehabilitation of Martvili Water Supply System. The design stipulates: 1) Implementation of construction works on the site of the headworks of Martvili Town, in particular: pouring of clean water in the manifold by arranging of the discharge pipe from the water collecting well of existing cappings; arranging of the drainage on the puddle site enables water flowed from the mountain slope to be poured in Inchkhuri River; Mounting of the main counter of the pipeline of D=200 mm, 2 pieces; 2) Implementation of construction works at the building of existing chlorinator and mounting of the new technological devices; there is arranged as well the automatic management system. 3) Arranging of gravity pipeline with the polyethylene pipe of D-200 mm. from the headworks till the network; 4) Rehabilitation of the depreciated sections of Martvili Town water distributing network; 5) Rehabilitation of the inner network of residential buildings.
 - Lot 3 Rehabilitation of Tsageri Water Supply Headwork "Tsivtskaro". The project envisages replacement of amortized operating pumps with the power intensive pumps, replacement of the pipes, mounting of the water meters, replacement of the mainline, repairs of the capping, fencing of the site.

Works for Lot 1 are expected to be implemented from February 2012 through April 2012.

Works for Lot 2 are expected to be implemented from February 2012 through August 2012.

Works for Lot 3 are expected to be implemented from February 2012 through May 2012.

- 3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the EIB's Guidelines: Guide to Procurement, February 2004 and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source.

- 5. To be qualified for award the bidder shall meet the following criteria and present the documents to confirm that as a minimum:
 - (a) The minimum required average annual turnover of construction works for the successful Bidder in the last three years shall be: Lot 1 GEL 2 500 000; Lot 2 GEL 3 500 000; Lot 3 GEL 2 900 000.
 - (b) The minimum amount of liquid assets and/or credit facilities net of other contractual commitments shall be: Lot 1 GEL 550 000; Lot 2 GEL 800 000; Lot 3 GEL 650 000.

A margin of preference for certain goods manufactured domestically "shall not" be applied. Additional details are provided in the Bidding Documents.
