Georgia has received a loan from the European Investment Bank (hereinafter referred to as "the Bank") toward the cost of Water Infrastructure Modernization Project, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to payments under the Contract for Rehabilitation of Baghdati (Stage I), Zestafoni and Tkibuli Municipality Water Supply Systems for The United Water Supply Company of Georgia (Contract # EIB/WIMP/W/ICB/14).

  Lot 1 Rehabilitation of Baghdati Water Supply System (Stage I Installation of consumer water meters). The works include: arranging of the wells of water meters on water inlet pipes at residential houses of the town.
  Lot 2 Rehabilitation of Water Supply System in Tkibuli Municipality. The project envisages: 1) Rehabilitation of the central water treatment facility of Tkibuli Town's Water Supply System; 2) Arranging of "SCADA" (automated system of management) on the chloral station; 3) Arranging of proper units for further provision of consumers with the water counters; 4) Rehabilitation of damaged sections of existing central mainline and distributing network;
  - Lot 3 Rehabilitation of Zestafoni Water Supply System. The project envisages: 1) On 'Khokhula' headwork rehabilitation works for the pump station including technical equipment and piping, electrotechnical part, replacement of the pressure pipeline initial section 500m long, arrangement of the sanitary fencing, overhaul of the chlorination plant including technical equipment and piping, electrotechnical part; 2) On the town headwork rehabilitation works for the pump station including technical equipment and piping, electrotechnical part, creation of the sanitary zone, overhaul of the chlorination plant including technical equipment and piping, electrotechnical part, repair of the drain shaft, rehabilitation of the laboratory. 3)

Rehabilitation of Gorgasali 1000 m<sup>3</sup> reservoir, Installation of the water pipeline by using 200 mm steel pipe from the pump station to the Gorgasali reservoir, installation of the water supply network on Mazniashvili street, by using 160mm pipe.

  - (b) The minimum amount of liquid assets and/or credit facilities net of other contractual commitments shall be: Lot 1 GEL 400 000; Lot 2 GEL 500 000; Lot 3 GEL 1 500 000.
  - A margin of preference for certain goods manufactured domestically "shall not" be applied. Additional details are provided in the Bidding Documents.
